The Planning and Zoning Commission held a called meeting Thursday, September 28, 2017 at Town Hall to review proposed amendments to the town's nuisance ordinances and a proposed swimming pool fencing ordinance. The meeting was called to order at 7:23 p.m. and a quorum was present.

Members present: Mrs. Garvin, Mr. Boggs, Mr. Vaughan and Mr. Mitchell
Also present: Mayor Poindexter, Attorney Eller, and Mr. Hodges

The following draft ordinance amendments were reviewed:

- Sec. 10-1. Definitions (as to nuisances)
- Sec. 10-2. Illustrative enumeration (as to nuisances)
- Sec. 10-15. Allowing filth, etc. to accumulate on premises
- Sec. 10-17. Condition of premises (weed ordinance)
- Sec. 10-20. Solid waste disposal procedure
- Sec. 8-43. Inoperable vehicles

All drafts were discussed and a vote taken, with a recommendation to Council to advertise the proposed changes, as presented, for public hearing.

Also considered for addition as a new section to the Town Ordinances was:

Sec. 10-22. Fencing of swimming pools.

A vote was taken, with a recommendation to council to advertise the proposed new ordinance section, as presented, for public hearing.


Motion: Mr. Mitchell Second: Mrs. Garvin Passage: unanimous
