

The Hurt Town Council held a special called closed session meeting at Town Hall on Monday, October 17, 2016 to discuss prospective business and economic development. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. and a quorum was declared present.

Members present: Mitchell, Blackstock, Bivens, and Neal. (Absent: Johnson)

A motion was made to enter into closed session to discuss prospective business and economic development (per FOIA Sec. 2.2-3711(A)(5)) and passed without discussion.

Motion: Mr. Neal Second: Mr. Mitchell Passage: unanimous

Closed session began at 6:03 p.m. and concluded at 7:05 p.m.

A motion was made to certify that only prospective business and economic development were discussed in closed session.

There was discussion about moving the date of the November council meeting due to the mayor, council and staff attending the Pittsylvania County Planning Commission meeting Tuesday, November 1, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. and the Board of Supervisors' meeting Tuesday, November 15, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in support of Runk and Pratt's request that the county rezone land on which they intend to situate The Willows, a senior living community. Attorney John Eller advised that a resolution should be passed to move the meeting.

A motion was made to pass a resolution rescheduling the November council meeting from Tuesday, November 1, 2016 to Monday, November 14, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Blackstock asked about updating/improving Council Chambers, such as painting.

A motion was made to "paint from baseboards to ceiling" and passed without discussion.
