* * * * * **Public Hearing Protocols** * * * * *

Hurt Town Council appreciates and welcomes input from town citizens, both residential and corporate. A public hearing, as its name indicates, is a time for town officials to hear comments from the citizenry. It is not an informal group conversation or ongoing question-and-answer session.

This is a meeting of a local governing body. In the interest of time, for everyone to hear and think clearly, and to preserve a suitable environment, we respectfully ask that the following procedural guidelines be observed:

- ❖ Please silence all electronic devices and avoid other audio/visual disturbances.
- ❖ Only one person should be speaking aloud at any given moment.
- ❖ Persons desiring to address Council must write their names legibly on the sign-up sheet before the hearing begins. Names are called by order on the sheet.
- ❖ It is expected that all speakers be residents of or property owners within the town limits, or duly appointed agents functioning on behalf of same.
- ❖ For the record, each speaker should first state his/her name and speak audibly.
- ❖ Unless extra time is granted by the mayor, each speaker must limit his or her remarks to one (1) time slot, with a time limit of four (4) minutes per person.
- ❖ The maximum duration of this public hearing is one hour from the time it opens. Persons who sign up but don't get an opportunity to speak during the 1-hour window will be given first priority to speak during the next council meeting.
- ❖ Comments are to be directed to the council as a body whole, not to individuals.
- ❖ Personal attacks, profanity, and disorderly conduct are not permitted, and may result in the offender(s) having to leave the room.
- ❖ All comments submitted during a public hearing should pertain to the matter at hand (budget, tax, etc.). Remarks concerning other topics should be presented during the Hearing of Citizens part of a meeting.
